What they Do

1 Family and Marriage Counselors

Family and marriage counsellors often specialize in dealing with a specific client group such as injured workers, or with specific problems, such as drug and alcohol addiction, marital difficulties or behavioural disorders.

A. May provide public education and consultation to other professionals or groups regarding counselling services, issues and methods

B. May conduct research, publish research papers, educational texts and articles and deliver presentations at conferences.

2 Employment Counsellors

A. Interview clients to obtain employment history, educational background and career goals

B. Identify barriers to employment and assist clients with such matters as job readiness skills, job search strategies, and preparing for job interviews

C. Administer tests designed to determine the interests, aptitudes and abilities of clients

D. Assess need for assistance such as rehabilitation, financial aid or further vocational training and refer clients to the appropriate services

3 Managers in Financial & Business Services

A. Insurance, Real Estate and Financial Brokerage
Managers plan, organize, direct, control and evaluate the operation of an establishment or department that provides insurance services, buys, sells and leases property, finds lenders or lending institutions and buys and sells stocks, bonds and other forms of investments.

B. Banking, Credit and Other Investment Managers
plan, organize, direct, control and evaluate the branch operations of a bank, trust company, credit union or similar financial institution responsible for administering personal and commercial loans, buying and selling securities, operating investment funds, administering trusts, or settling estates.

4 Managers in Public Administration

Managers in public administration direct the development, implementation, and evaluation of government policies, research, and programs and manage human and financial resources.

A. Government managers in health and social fields are concerned with the protection of health and social welfare for individuals/communities.

B. Government managers in the field of economics are involved in areas such as taxation, labour markets, transportation, international trade, and business development.
