What they Do

1 Network Technicians

- A. Conduct tests and perform security and quality controls
- B. Control and monitor e-mail use, Web navigation, and installed software
- C. Perform shell scripting or other basic scripting tasks
- D. Maintain, troubleshoot and administer the use of local area networks, wide area networks, mainframe networks, computer workstations, connections to the Internet and peripheral equipment

2 Insurance Agents

- A. Sell automobile, fire, health, life, property, marine, aircraft and other types of insurance to clients
- B. Establish client insurance coverage, calculate premiums and establish method of payment

- D. Ensure appropriate forms, medical examinations and other policy requirements are completed

3 Employment Counsellors

Employment counsellors perform some or all of the following duties:

- A. Interview clients to obtain employment history, educational background and career goals
- B. Identify barriers to employment and assist clients with such matters as job readiness skills, job search strategies, and preparing for job interviews
- C. Advise employers on human resource and other employment-related issues
- D. Administer and interpret tests designed to determine the interests, aptitudes and abilities of clients

4 Transportation Equipment Mechanics

- A. Heavy-duty equipment mechanics repair and maintain construction, forestry, mining, material handling, and other heavy equipment.
- B. Refrigeration and air conditioning mechanics install and repair refrigeration, central air conditioning, and combined cooling/heating systems in homes, businesses, and industry.
- C. Aircraft mechanics maintain and repair aircraft structures and mechanical/hydraulic systems.
