## What they Do

### 1 Electronics Assemblers and Fabricators

Electronics assemblers and fabricators perform some or all of the following duties:

A. Inspect electronic components and assemblies to ensure correct component selection and placement, wiring and soldering quality, proper pin insertions, location and diameter of plated holes, breaks in circuitry and line spacing in printed circuit board and

B. Check final assembly for finish, labelling and packaging methods

C. Identify and mark acceptable and defective assemblies and return faulty assemblies to production for repair

### 2 Finance and Insurance Administration

A. Loan officers evaluate and process credit/loan applications.

B. Insurance adjusters investigate insurance claims and determine the amount of loss or damages covered by policies.

C. Insurance claims examiners review insurance claims and authorize payments.

D. Insurance underwriters evaluate insurance applications to determine insurance risks, premiums, and coverage.

### 3 Interior Designers

Interior designers perform some or all of the following duties:

A. Consult with clients to determine needs, preferences, safety requirements and purpose of space

B. Develop detailed plans and 3-D models showing arrangement of walls, dividers, displays, lighting and other fixtures using computer-assisted design (CAD) software and graphics software

C. Develop plans, elevations, cross sections and detailed drawings, and advise on selection of colours, finishes and materials, floor and wall coverings, interior and exterior lighting, furniture and other items, taking into account ergonomic and occupational health standards

### 4 Mechanical Assemblers and Inspectors

Assemblers in this unit group perform some or all of the following duties:

A. Test and check electrical assemblies and wiring for proper connections

B. Perform minor adjustments and repairs.

C. Assemble, fit and install prefabricated parts to form subassemblies or finish products using hand and power tools
